Representatives from the NJDEP will show you how to effectively use regulations and guidance documents when conducting site investigation and remediation activities to attain compliance with the Industrial Site Recovery Act, the Underground Storage of Hazardous Substance Act and the Spill Compensation and Control Act, along with associated Administrative Consent Orders and Voluntary Cleanups. NJDEP SRP personnel will present case studies to help demonstrate how to prepare and submit workplans and report packages.

- Delineation of Contaminants & Compliance Averaging
- Deed Notices and Classification Exception Areas
