**TO: ALL INSURERS TRANSACTING PRIVATE PASSENGER
AUTOMOBILE INSURANCE IN NEW JERSEY**

**RE: QUARTERLY UEZ IN-FORCE PRIVATE PASSENGER
AUTOMOBILE EXPOSURE REPORTS**

The rule governing the quarterly reporting of UEZ in-force private passenger automobile exposures by zip code, N.J.A.C. 11:3-46.13(a), requires member insurers to file such reports, no less frequently than quarterly. The rules governing the reporting requirements and filing deadlines of all insurers that write private passenger automobile insurance, N.J.A.C. 11:3-3A.1 et seq., include the semi-annual reporting of private passenger automobile exposures by zip code, including UEZs. The Department of Banking and Insurance (“Department”) is in the process of reviewing these rules and intends to propose amendments in the near future. Specifically, the Department intends to repeal the rule that requires the separate submission of the UEZ quarterly in-force exposure reports, as it has been determined that the semi-annual reporting of such data by zip code pursuant to N.J.A.C. 11:3-3A.1 et seq. provides the Department with sufficient UEZ in-force exposure data. Consequently, the filing of the quarterly reports of the UEZ data is no longer necessary.

The purpose of this Bulletin is to advise member insurers that, consistent with the Common Sense Principles for Rulemaking pronounced in Governor Christie’s Executive Order No. 2, the Department will not enforce the reporting requirement imposed by N.J.A.C. 11:3-46.13(a). Accordingly, effective immediately, the filing of the UEZ quarterly in-force exposure reports is no longer required, as the data within the reports required by N.J.A.C. 11:3-3A.1 et seq. to be submitted semi-annually on January 31 and July 31 of each year, with evaluation dates of December 31 and June 30, respectively, is sufficient.
