Obj. to create and present a multimedia presentation using appropriate software (MaxShow) by creating individual slides to be compiled in a class presentation (teacher selected topic).

<u>Content</u> Insert-New Slide: ability to add and delete slides	first slide contains author's name; second slide contains sentences that are awkward to read	first slide contains author's name; second slide contains simple sentences	first slide contains author's name; second slide contains well-written sentences
<u>Presentation Layout</u> Format Font: size use of drawing and painting tools; Insert-Picture (from clip art, file)	difficult to read; text is incomplete; spacing between words is inconsistent; no graphics were used or were inappropriate	easy-to-read; text is complete; spacing between words is inconsistent no graphics were used or were inappropriate	easy-to-read; text is complete; appropriate spacing between words graphics were appropriate and added to the presentation
<u>Edit</u> use of Grammar Check and Spell Check use of punctuation at the end of sentences; capitalize at beginning of sentences and names	several errors in grammar, capitalization, punctuation, and/or spelling	fewer than 2 errors in grammar, capitalization, punctuation, and/or spelling	no errors in grammar, capitalization, punctuation, and/or spelling
<u>Save</u> document to a file using Save or Save As and creating a file name	automatically presses Save ; saves to the program file or computer	needs guidance in saving document to own folder on the server	saves to own folder on the server; understands difference between Save and Save as
<u>Oral presentation</u>	choppy delivery but holds audience attention	smooth delivery that holds audience attention	well-rehearsed; smooth delivery that holds audience attention
