The Franklin Township School District is located in rural Hunterdon County. This one-school district provides a pre-kindergarten through 8th grade education for approximately 310 - 320 students. The school's preschool integrated program offers opportunities for regular education tuition students and special needs students to attend a ten hour per week educational program utilizing the "Tools of the Mind" curriculum.

Our overall mission is to “foster excellence” while meeting the needs of students as individual learners. The Franklin Township School District continues to effectively and efficiently develop an annual school budget that provides a comprehensive and academically challenging school program. The educational program includes integrated language arts (reading writing, listening, and speaking), Mathematics, social studies, Spanish, physical education and health, art, music, band, and study skills. Library, technology, and enrichment activities are integrated into all academic disciplines, through a multi-disciplinary approach to learning. The district offers small class sizes and a lower than average student teacher ratio. More than seventy-five percent of the staff hold advanced degrees, while one-hundred percent of the staff meets the federally established Highly Qualified Teacher (HQT) standards..
