PROGRAM:

The Hoboken School District offers a unique learning experience in a small urban environment. The district configuration includes an early childhood program for PreK3 and PreK4 as well as Kindergarten students, three elementary schools (PreK-7), and one high school with a five year program (8-12).

The Hoboken School District utilizes the Tools of the Mind (T.O.M.) curriculum for the early childhood program. Tools of the Mind is a research-based early childhood curriculum that builds strong foundations for school success in preschool and kindergarten.

The Hoboken School District has infused technology throughout its curriculum. All classrooms and school libraries are equipped with computers, and each school has at least one computer lab for large group instruction. In 2010-2011, the district implemented a One-to-One laptop program in which all students in grades 7 and 8 received a netbook for use in school and at home. The use of technology extends to computer-assisted assessments, individualized supplemental software programs, and the increased use of interactive whiteboards for classroom instruction.

The Hoboken School District is engaged in several multi-year, long term professional development partnerships as a means of bringing state-of-the-art professional development to staff throughout the district in programs such as Writers' Workshop with LitLife consultants (grades 1-5); Students Press Initiative (SPI) associated with Teachers' College at Hoboken High School; Partnership to Improve Student Achievement (PISA) at Stevens Institute of Technology; and Caldwell College which provides onsite graduate studies in literacy.

Hoboken High School's comprehensive curriculum, designed to serve a variety of student educational interests, includes a rigorous core academic program and Advanced Placement (AP) courses, in addition to vocational education offerings such as Cosmetology and Culinary Arts. Hoboken High School students have many opportunities for creative and individual expression
