PROGRAM:

The Ogdensburg Public School is located between the Wallkill River and Sparta Mountain in Northern New Jersey. The scenic area is surrounded by preserved forest areas and parks but is only 54 miles from New York City. The school reflects the historical importance of mining in the area and is named after mine owner Robert Ogden. The district collaborates with the nearby Sterling Hill Mining Museum to highlight the technological advances brought to the borough by Thomas Edison and focusing on the importance of mining in today's economy. In partnership with Montclair University, the school shares experts in math and science through a Professional Resources in Science and Math program.
