Request to Extend the Five-Year Plan for Career and Technical Education for 2016-2017

The New Jersey Department of Education has requested an extension from USDE for its Five-Year State Plan for Career and Technical Education with some revisions for 2016-2017. Accordingly, local recipients must also request an extension of their Five-Year Plan for CTE for 2016-2017.

To request an extension of your Five-Year Plan for CTE for 2016-2017 local recipients must submit a letter from the College President/Agency Director to Marie Barry, Assistant Division Director, Office of Career and Technical Education at the New Jersey Department of Education, P.O. Box 500, Trenton, NJ 08625.

The language below is provided for use in your institution's Five-Year Plan extension request letter. After including the language in your letter, select a check box indicating whether you would like to extend your Five-Year Plan for CTE **without revisions (Option 1) or with revisions (Option 2)**.

Option 1: I have reviewed my institution's Five-Year/Multi-Year Plan goals and objectives and request an extension of the plan without revisions.

or

Option 2: I have reviewed my institution's Five-Year/Multi-Year Plan goals and objectives and request an extension of the plan with revisions. I understand that the revisions must be provided before my institution's Perkins application can be approved.
