This endorsement entitles the holder to teach Latin in all public schools in Grades 5-8.

The following requirements must be met for certification:

Degree Requirement

- A minimum of a bachelor's degree is required from a [regionally accredited college/university](http://www.nj.gov/education/educators/license/usaccred.htm). (<http://www.nj.gov/education/educators/license/usaccred.htm>)

Cumulative GPA Requirement

- New Jersey requires that candidates for certification achieve a cumulative GPA of at least 2.75 when a GPA of 4.00 equals an A grade for students graduating on or after September 1, 2004 (2.50 for those graduating before September 1, 2004) in a baccalaureate degree program, higher degree program or a State-approved post-baccalaureate certification program with a minimum of 13 semester-hour credits. Please note that a high praxis test score may offset a GPA that is lower than 2.75 but higher than 2.50. Elementary School Certification

- Current regulations for certification require that applicants hold an Elementary School certificate in order to be eligible for Elementary School with Subject Matter Specialization Certificate (Middle School Certificate). You need to apply and be eligible for the Elementary School certificate. Issuance of the Elementary School with Subject Matter Specialization certificate will be contingent upon eligibility for the Elementary School certification.

Subject Matter Preparation

- Current regulations for certification require that applicants complete a minimum of 15 credits in the subject area that you want to be certified in. Courses in educational pedagogy do not count towards the subject matter requirement. All credits must appear on a regionally accredited 2 OR 4 year college/university transcript.

24 Hour Requirement

- Effective October 31, 2009, eligibility for the elementary school (K-5) Certificate of Eligibility or instructional area Certificate of Eligibility requires candidates to demonstrate knowledge of basic pedagogical skills appropriate to the area of endorsement prior to the issuance of a certificate. The requirement may be met through successful completion of a minimum of 24 hours of study offered through a state-approved provider or through approved coursework at a NJ State-approved college as documented on a transcript. If submitting a Certificate of Completion for the 24 hour pre-service to meet this requirement, only original documentation will be accepted. Do not send copies or faxes. Latin Test Requirement

- You must complete **The Latin Test for Teacher Certification** which meets the American Council on the Teaching of Foreign Languages (ACTFL) standards for reading and writing at the *Advanced Level*, and assumes a comprehensive knowledge of the Latin language and Roman culture. There are 100 multiple choice questions. Eighty questions are on the Latin language and 20 questions deal with Roman culture, mythology, history and daily life. The passing grade is 75. Second Language Acquisition & Related Methodologies

- Please note that before a CEAS or *standard* certificate may be issued, a minimum of three semester-hour credits in second language acquisition theory and related methodologies offered by a regionally accredited two or four year college or university must be completed. A list of approved courses to meet this requirement can be accessed at the following website: www.state.nj.us/njded/aps/cccs/wl/courses.htm. **This course is not required in order to receive a CE.**

Course Requirement in the Characteristics of Child and Early Adolescent Development

- A course in “Child and Early Adolescent Development,” or its equivalent, that appears on a regionally accredited 2 or 4 year college or university transcript is required. Acceptable courses include “Adolescent Psychology/Development” and “Lifespan Development”. A course titled “Child Psychology” will **not** be accepted unless it covers the development of adolescents between the ages of 11-14 (**This course is not required for issuance of a CE. At this time, please be advised that this study is contained in the Provisional Training Program for alternate route candidates.**)

Physiology and Hygiene Requirement

- This requirement may be completed by presenting evidence of basic military training, OR by completing a course such as biology, health or nutrition that appears on a regionally accredited 2 or 4 year college or university transcript, OR by completing a 35 question True/False test administered in the county office of education.
