

# MARGIT FELDMAN TEACHING AWARD

***Margit Feldman Award*** – Established by her family and the New Jersey Commission on Holocaust Education in her honor. Margit is a survivor of the Holocaust who has taught children about her experience for over 30 years.

## **Criteria:**

- Open to teachers in Somerset, Morris, Hunterdon, Union, Sussex and Warren Counties.
- Educating the students about the importance of being an “upstander”. (One who cares about others and doesn’t let the bully prevail).
- A teacher may be nominated by peers, supervisor, parents and/or students utilizing the nomination form which will then be reviewed by the New Jersey Commission on Holocaust Education and the Feldman family.

Margit’s presentation also includes the winning classroom teacher will receive a financial award for continuation of their work in the classroom and educational material. They will also receive a certificate of recognition from the New Jersey Commission on Holocaust Education.

**Venue** – Presented at the end of school year at the Commission meeting.

**Nominations for these awards presented by the New Jersey Commission on Holocaust Education may be accepted from private citizens, community and religious groups, Holocaust Centers, government officials, etc. All nominations will be reviewed by the Commission or a subcommittee established by the Commission with final selection made by the Commission.**
