## **SYNOPSIS**

Petitioning Board filed tenure charges of unbecoming conduct and insubordination against respondent, a tenured secretary, and sought her removal from employment in the Township of Fairfield School District. Respondent filed an answer to the charges, but subsequently submitted an irrevocable letter of resignation dated January 7, 2008. On January 8, 2008, the petitioning Board issued a resolution accepting respondent's resignation and withdrawing the tenure charges.

The ALJ found that the respondent resigned from her tenured employment, and holds no certificate issued by the New Jersey Department of Education. Accordingly, the ALJ concluded that the matter should be dismissed as moot.

The Commissioner concurred with the ALJ, and dismissed the petition as moot.

The record of this matter and the Initial Decision of the Office of Administrative Law (OAL) have been reviewed.
