SYNOPSIS

In June 2012, the petitioner – an adult student – filed a request for emergency relief to permit her to graduate from North Bergen High School and to attend commencement. The parties reached a tentative settlement of the issues, and petitioner confirmed on the record that she consented to the adjournment of the emergency hearing. On July 19, 2012, petitioner advised the ALJ that she would submit a letter withdrawing her emergent application. In October 2012, petitioner advised the ALJ's office that she had received her high school diploma, and again stated that she would send a letter withdrawing her original application for emergent relief. No letter was every received.

The ALJ found that petitioner has knowingly and voluntarily withdrawn her emergent relief application, concluded that the matter is now moot, and ordered that the matter be dismissed with prejudice.

The Commissioner concurred with the ALJ's findings, and determined that the case is appropriately dismissed as moot.
