At its meeting of May 14, 1998 the State Board of Examiners reviewed your application for certification following revocation made pursuant to <u>N.J.A.C.</u> 6:11-3.6(g). The Board carefully considered your letter of March 3, 1998 in which you summarized your understanding of the circumstances that led to the revocation of your county substitute license in March of 1996 and your statements concerning rehabilitation. It also reviewed the letters of recommendation submitted on your behalf by your recent employers. The Board also reviewed the settlement documents related to the revocation proceedings against your county substitute licensure brought before the State Board of Examiners dated June 18, 1996. Upon careful review of the record of this matter, the Board voted to block issuance of a new county substitute license to you. *

Appeal of this decision is made before the Commissioner of Education pursuant to <u>N.J.A.C.</u> 6:24-1 *et seq*.
