At it meeting of December 7, 2000, the State Board of Examiners reviewed an affidavit forwarded by the Morris County Prosecutor's Office. The affidavit was signed by John E. Burke, who holds Teacher of Secretarial Studies, Teacher of General Business Studies, Teacher Coordinator of Business Education, School Administrator Certificate of Eligibility and Principal/Supervisor certificates in New Jersey. As a result of a criminal prosecution, Burke was allowed to enter a Pre-Trial Intervention (PTI) program. In addition, Burke agreed to surrender his administrative certificates only. The Morris County Prosecutor's Office had entered into an agreement with Burke that includes the voluntary surrender of his School Administrator Certificate of Eligibility and his Principal/Supervisor certificates.

In furtherance of that agreement, the Prosecutor's Office submitted to the State Board of Examiners an affidavit Burke signed waiving his right to a hearing pursuant to <u>N.J.A.C.</u> 6:11-3.6 and acknowledging that the surrender of his certificates would have the force and effect of a revocation. The affidavit was reviewed at the December 7, 2000 State Board of Examiners meeting.

Having confirmed that the certificate holder has agreed to the revocation of his administrative certificates, it is therefore, ORDERED, that John Burke's School Administrator Certificate of Eligibility and Principal/Supervisor certificates be revoked on this 7th day of December 2000. It is further ORDERED that John E. Burke return his administrative certificates to the Secretary of the State Board of Examiners, Office of Licensing, P.O. Box 500, Trenton, NJ 08625-0500 within fifteen (15) days of receipt of this decision.
