PHILIP BEVILACQUA : ORDER OF REVOCATION

At its meeting of March 25, 2010, the State Board of Examiners reviewed an affidavit Philip Bevilacqua had forwarded. After pleading guilty to Theft of CDS, Bevilacqua was court-ordered to forfeit his teaching certificates. Bevilacqua currently holds a Teacher of Industrial Arts certificate, issued in September 1960, a Supervisor certificate and a Principal Certificate of Eligibility, both issued in June 2002 and a Principal certificate, issued in October 2003.

Bevilacqua agreed to forfeit his certificates with the force and effect of a revocation and all attendant consequences in his affidavit to that effect to the New Jersey State Board of Examiners. At its meeting of March 25, 2010, the Board voted to accept Bevilacqua's relinquishment with the force and effect of a revocation pursuant to *N.J.A.C. 6A:9-17.8*.

Accordingly, on this 25th day of March 2010 it is therefore ORDERED that the revocation of Philip Bevilacqua's Principal Certificate of Eligibility and Teacher of Industrial Arts, Supervisor and Principal certificates be effective immediately.
