JOHN A. BRISHCAR : ORDER OF REVOCATION

At its meeting of March 12, 2015, the New Jersey State Board of Examiners (Board) reviewed an affidavit that John A. Brishcar had submitted. In February 2015, Brishcar pled guilty to one count of second degree Theft by Deception. Pursuant to *N.J.S.A.* 2C:51-2, Brishcar was also ordered to forfeit any and all public employment and was forever disqualified from holding any office or position of honor, trust or profit under the State or any of its administrative or political subdivisions. Brishcar currently holds a Teacher of Physical Science certificate, issued in November 1992 and a Supervisor certificate, issued in April 1998.

Brishcar agreed to relinquish his certificates with the force and effect of a revocation and all attendant consequences in his affidavit to that effect to the Board. At its meeting of March 12, 2015, the Board voted to accept Brishcar's relinquishment with the force and effect of a revocation pursuant to *N.J.A.C.* 6A:9B-4.8.

Accordingly, on this 12th day of March 2015 it is therefore ORDERED that John A. Brishcar's Teacher of Physical Science and Supervisor certificates be revoked effective immediately.
