At its meeting of January 19, 2017, the New Jersey State Board of Examiners (Board) reviewed an affidavit that the Morris County Prosecutor's Office had submitted regarding Donna D. Peirce-Faley. On October 19, 2016, Peirce-Faley pled guilty to Criminal Sexual Contact and Abuse and Neglect of Child. Peirce-Faley was sentenced to probation and ordered to relinquish her teaching certificates. Peirce-Faley currently holds a Teacher of Art Certificate of Eligibility with Advanced Standing, issued in

Peirce-Faley agreed to relinquish her certificates with the force and effect of a revocation and all attendant consequences in her affidavit to that effect to the Board. At its meeting of January 19, 2017, the Board voted to accept Peirce-Faley's relinquishment with the force and effect of a revocation pursuant to *N.J.A.C.* 6A:9B-4.7.

February 2009 and a Teacher of Students with Disabilities Certificate of Eligibility, issued in June 2010.

Accordingly, on this 19th day of January 2017 it is therefore ORDERED that Donna D. Peirce-Faley's Teacher of Art Certificate of Eligibility With Advanced Standing and her Teacher of Students with Disabilities Certificate of Eligibility be revoked effective immediately.
