At its meeting of April 13, 2018, the New Jersey State Board of Examiners (Board) reviewed an affidavit that the Burlington County Prosecutor's Office had forwarded regarding Eric T. Howell. On March 14, 2018, Howell pled guilty to Endangering the Welfare of a Child-Sexual Conduct. As a result of the conviction, Howell was disqualified from public school employment pursuant to *N.J.S.A.* 18A:6-7.1 *et seq.* Howell currently holds a Teacher of Chemistry Certificate of Eligibility with Advanced Standing and a Teacher of Chemistry Provisional certificate, which expires in July 2018.

Howell agreed to relinquish his certificates with the force and effect of a revocation and all attendant consequences in his affidavit to that effect to the Board. At its meeting of April 13, 2018, the Board voted to accept Howell's relinquishment with the force and effect of a revocation pursuant to *N.J.A.C.* 6A:9B-4.7.

Accordingly, on this 13th day of April 2018, it is therefore ORDERED that Eric T. Howell's Teacher of Chemistry Certificate of Eligibility with Advanced Standing and Teacher of Chemistry Provisional certificate are hereby revoked, effective immediately.
