The decision of the Assistant Commissioner of Education disqualifying petitioner from school employment is affirmed for the reasons expressed therein. We stress that petitioner had been convicted of manslaughter and that she had been disqualified from employment as a school bus driver, a position requiring considerable responsibility for the care and safety of children. See N.J.S.A. 18A:6-7.1(e)(1) and (2). We note, in addition, that petitioner had certified on her authorization form provided to the Office of Criminal History Review that she had not been convicted of any disqualifying offenses, including manslaughter.
