This matter is before us pursuant to a remand by the Appellate Division. In its decision, the Court affirmed the decision of the State Board of Education to revoke the respondent's principal and supervisor certificates as a result of her action breaching the security of the Elementary School Proficiency Assessment Test while employed as a principal. However, the Court reversed the State Board's decision to revoke the respondent's instructional certification in elementary education. The Court found that the decision to revoke the respondent's instructional certification was not sufficiently

related to the facts to be justified, and it remanded this matter to the State Board of Education for modification of that decision so as to comport with the Court's opinion.

In view of the Court's decision, we remand this matter to the State Board of Examiners to fulfill the terms of that decision. We do not retain jurisdiction.
