This workshop will provide an overview of required IEP components and considerations as mandated by IDEA 2004 and the New Jersey Special Education Regulations, N.J.A.C. 6A:14. Participants will gain an understanding of the IEP decision making process and learn how to create a coherent document that brings together the collective perspectives of educators, families, and students. Particular emphasis will be placed on the following IEP components: present levels of academic achievement and functional performance; behavior intervention plans; measurable annual academic and functional goals; supplementary aids and services; supports for school personnel; transition to adult life; and placement in the least restrictive environment.
