Program Description

Devereux Glenholme School provides a therapeutic learning environment for male and female students, ages 10-21 years, who have emotional disturbance, social maladjustment, specific learning disability, Asperger's syndrome, communication impairment, and other health impairment. The therapeutic treatment program is behaviorally based and client-centered. Goals and objectives are developed from a Functional Behavioral Analysis and implemented in accordance with the Glenholme Motivational Management Approach. Placement in any education class is based on academic appropriateness. Class size ratios are determined according to the needs of each group of students. Lower school students are in self-contained classes. Upper school classes are departmentalized. Students are placed in cottage groups with peers of the same approximate age, functioning level, and interests. The morning program centers on daily living skills. After school, there are sports and clubs with a focus on equestrian, music, art, and drama. Related services are not included in the education costs.
