## 2008 - 2009 Timelines:

Nonpublic school indicates desire to participate in Nonpublic School Technology Initiative on the Nonpublic School Enrollment form. (Judith Miller contacted any school that participated in the Nonpublic School Technology Initiative last year and did not respond that they wanted to participate this year after the submission date. Any nonpublic school that did not respond to Judith's letter or on the Nonpublic School Enrollment form will not be eligible this year.)	November Prior to this school year
NJDOE supplies entitlement figure to the public school	July 2008
Payment sent from NJDOE to the public school as a lump sum.	July 31, 2008
Nonpublic school consults with public school  <i>Allow time for the public school to add the topic to the agenda prior to the public session of the public school Board of Education (BOE) meeting.</i>	Prior to the October public school Board of Education meeting
Nonpublic school submits request to public school  <i>It is suggested that this be completed by the end of September.</i>	Determined by LEA
Public school's BOE approves nonpublic school request at Board meeting	By October
