

New Jersey Meadowlands Commission

Code of Ethics

The New Jersey Meadowlands Commission (“Commission”) was created pursuant to New Jersey Statute §13:17-1 et seq. The Uniform Ethics Code shall be the primary code of ethics for the Commission’s members and employees. In accordance with the New Jersey Conflicts of Interest Law N.J.S.A. 52:13D-23(a)(1), the Commission adopts this supplement to the Uniform Ethics Code to govern the conduct of the Commission’s employees.

I. OUTSIDE ACTIVITIES AND BUSINESS INTERESTS

- (1) No member, officer, employee or agent of the commission shall be financially interested, either directly or indirectly, in any project or any part of a project area (other than a residence) or in any contract, sale, purchase, lease or transfer of real or personal property to which the commission is a party;
- (2) Any contract or agreement knowingly made in contravention of this section is voidable;
- (3) Any person who shall willfully violate any of the provisions of this section shall forfeit his office or employment and shall be guilty of a misdemeanor.
