This matter arises from an allegation that Lisa Coscia, Former Chief Executive Officer, Hunterdon Developmental Center (“HDC”), Division of Developmental Disabilities, misused State resources and her position as a State employee to provide an unwarranted benefit to herself and/or others by arranging a trip for HDC residents to attend a play at Voorhees High School.

After considering the results of an investigation into the allegations, the Commission dismissed the matter pursuant to *N.J.A.C.* 19:61-3.1(g).
