**DECISION** 

This matter arises from an allegation that Donald Roberts, the former Chief of Licensing, Operations and Investigations, Office of Emergency Medical Services, Department of Health, failed to recuse from an investigation involving Robert Wood Johnson University Hospital Mobile Health Service ("RWJUH") at a time when he had a pending application for employment with RWJUH.

After considering the results of an investigation into the allegations, the Commission **dismissed** the matter pursuant to *N.J.A.C.* 19:61-3.1(g).
