Walter F. Timpone is an accomplished former prosecutor, public servant, and lawyer who is currently a partner at the law firm of McElroy, Deutsch, Mulvaney & Carpenter, LLP

- His practice is concentrated in the areas of white collar crime, corporate internal investigations, health care compliance and defense, labor law and complex civil litigation.
- Mr. Timpone also represents health care industry organizations, companies, institutions, and individuals.
- He has successfully negotiated Deferred Prosecution Agreements – agreements that ensure appropriate reforms of corporate operations, practices, culture and ethics in the event of alleged criminality – for public and private health care organizations.
- Mr. Timpone acts as an Associate General Executive Board Attorney for the LIUNA Union where he investigates, charges, and takes to hearing union members for violations of the union's constitution and ethics procedures.

Mr. Timpone also currently serves as a Commissioner on the New Jersey Election Law Enforcement Commission

- He was appointed to the Commission in October 2010 by Governor Chris Christie.

Beginning in 1984, Mr. Timpone served in the United States Attorney's Office in Newark for 11 years

- Mr. Timpone was the Chief of Special Prosecutions while in the United States Attorney's Office where he led the prosecutions and convictions of nearly twenty-five public officials for corruption and fraud against the public.
- Prior to joining the United States Attorney's Office, Mr. Timpone was associated with the firm of Townley & Updike in New York City.

Mr. Timpone has served as the first Federal Election Monitor in Passaic County

- He was charged with ensuring the voting rights of the County's Hispanic citizens and the County's compliance with Federal and State consent orders.

Mr. Timpone served on a panel investigating problems surrounding the Department of Motor Vehicles Inspection Program & as an ombudsman to the United States Department of Defense

- At the appointment of N.J. Attorney General John Farmer, Mr. Timpone served on a panel charged by Governor Whitman with investigating problems surrounding the Department of Motor Vehicles Inspection Program.
- He acted as ombudsman to the United States Department of Defense overseeing a Defense Department contractor who entered a guilty plea concerning failed parts prepared for inclusion in Patriot missiles.

Mr. Timpone received his law degree from Seton Hall University in 1979 and was a former law clerk to the late Honorable Vincent P. Biunno.

- Mr. Timpone graduated from St. Francis College in New York in 1972 and received a Master's degree in Special Education from New York University in 1974.
- Mr. Timpone has extensive trial experience, and is admitted to practice in New Jersey and New York as well as the United States Supreme Court, Federal District Courts of New Jersey and the Northern, Southern, and Eastern Districts of New York.
