Historic Preservation Grants by municipality 1992 to 2011

These tables report **all matching grants** from the first NJ Historic Trust grant round in 1992 to the most recent FY2011 appropriations. The grants provide for the preservation, rehabilitation or interpretation of crucial historic sites owned by the State, municipalities, counties and nonprofit organizations.

The Statewide table shows the town, the number of historic project sites in that town, the total number of grants awarded to those sites and the sum of these grants.

The County by County tables list the number of historic projects in each town and the grants awarded for work at those sites. Some project sites receive multiple grants over the years.

About half of these funds came through the Garden State Historic Preservation Trust. About half the grants came from the 1989, 1992, 1995, 2007 & 2009 referendum bond funds. Only referendum bond funds may be used for State Park historic sites and other historic assets owned and managed by the NJDEP.

These tables are limited to projects recommended by the NJ Historic Trust. These tables do not include historic preservation or interpretive projects funded by the NJ Cultural Trust or the NJ Historical Commission.
