# PRESERVATION statistics

## Garden State Preservation Trust *Land Acquisition by municipality* Fiscal Year 2000 to Fiscal Year 2012

These tables report municipal parks, county parks, state parks, state and local wildlife refuges, private farmland and watershed areas permanently preserved for public benefit by the use of public funds to purchase public land or to purchase the development rights on privately owned land.

The statistics are broken down by municipality to show the preservation accomplishments in each town under the Garden State Preservation Trust period from FY2000 to June 2012.

This chart reports statistics for large farms whose acres span multiple municipalities. Statistics accounting for multi-municipal farms *have never* been compiled before. Statewide, 7% of all preserved farms have land that occupies more than one municipality.

- ✓ These tables **DO NOT INCLUDE** land preserved from 1962 to June 1999.
- ✓ These tables do not include land restricted from development without the use of State public funds. For example, land preserved by transfer of development rights (TDR) is **NOT** included. Land preserved by donation to the New Jersey Natural Lands Trust or to private foundations or to nonprofit land trusts is **NOT** included.
- ✓ These tables **MAY NOT YET INCLUDE** land that has been acquired by counties or land trusts for which a State grant was pending in June 2012.
