Dear Cancer Registrar:

The New Jersey State Cancer Registry (NJSCR) is pleased to announce that we are offering registries an Award for Excellence in Timely and Complete Cancer Case Reporting.

All registries are encouraged to apply. Reporting facilities will be judged on both completeness and timeliness of reporting. The NJSCR plans to expand this award in the future to include data quality.

In order to be eligible to receive an award, you must meet the following criteria:

- ② Complete case finding from all potential case-finding sources.
- ② Submit all 2010 diagnosis year cancer case admissions to NJSCR in accordance with State law, (e.g., 6 months after diagnosis or 3 months after discharge).
- ② Submit all 2010 diagnosis year cancer cases by the July 1, 2011 deadline.
- ② Submit a signed Affidavit of Completeness and award application form by July 1, 2011 (included with this letter).

The NJSCR hopes that you will continue to work toward complete and timely submission of your cancer data and seek eligibility for this award. Should you have any questions, please call Gladys Dickson at (609) 588-3500.

AWARD FOR EXCELLENCE IN TIMELY CANCER CASE REPORTING

Application Process:

The enclosed application should include all of the data submitted from your facility by July 1, 2011. Please document case finding activities by completing each item in the table. If your facility does not maintain one or more of the sources listed, please write N/A and document that fact in the space provided. If you have not performed complete case finding by using all inpatient and outpatient sources within your facility, you will not be eligible for the award regardless of what your estimated completeness percentage suggests.

The enclosed application must be completed and received in this office no later than July 1, 2011 in order to be eligible for the 2010 Award for Excellence for Timely Cancer Case Reporting. There will be no exceptions!

Awards will be presented based on the following criteria:

1. Complete case finding from all potential sources must be completed for your facility.
2. Submit all cases diagnosed in the year 2010 by July 1, 2011 according to State regulations. This means the year of diagnosis for all case records must fall between the following value **1/1/2010 TO 12/31/2010**. This does not mean an accession year of 2010, such as cases diagnosed in December 2009; those cases were due June of 2010. This includes class of case 0, 1, 2, 3, 5, 6, 8, and 9. Also, clinically diagnosed cases must be included and those cases diagnosed in the physician's office and admitted for radioactive seeds.
3. You must include all case records that have a date of diagnosis that falls between the above values and were provided a service (**INPATIENTS, OUTPATIENTS, CLINIC PATIENTS, CONSULTS ONLY, SPECIMEN ONLY OR ANY OTHER AREA OF YOUR FACILITY**) between 01/01/2010 to 03/31/2011.
4. All case records that meet these criteria must be transmitted and received by NJSCR no later than **07/01/2011** (if a third party transmits case records, they are also subject to this cutoff date).
5. No more than **5%** of the case records may be received after **07/01/2011** to remain eligible (case records that have an eligible diagnosis date but are seen later than **07/01/2011** will not be counted).
6. You must mail or fax (609-588-3638) a signed and completed application form, which includes an affidavit.
7. If your facility was audited for 2010, you must have no outstanding cases.
