Opnning partner: Make sure the suit is zipped up to the neck and peel self-adhering strips and secure zipper flap		
OPerform range of motion evaluation: Extend arms and bend at waist, Squat, Extend arms twist left to right		
Opnning partner: Observe suit for gaps or restriction		
Opnning partner: Check all PPE to ensure complete coverage without	t gaps, tears, or visio	on obstructions
Acknowledge the entry person is ready     Team members are to enter utilizing a buddy system at all times
