The hearing will focus on the Maternal and Child Health Block Grant, as required by the Omnibus Budget Reconciliation Act (OBRA) of 1989, PL 101-239, Section 501 (A) (1) F (iii) p24 and the FFY2011-2012 WIC State Plan (Special Supplemental Nutrition Program for Women, Infants and Children). Interested parties may provide testimony in writing or verbal testimony at the public hearing. Verbal testimony should not exceed 5 minutes in length and should be accompanied by eight written copies of the testimony.
