#### **GENERAL DESCRIPTION**

Under the direction of the Microbiology Program Manager or other supervisory officer, supervises the testing activities and staff of the Microbiology's Sanitary Bacteriology Unit. This unit tests water and milk/dairy products following the regulations generated by the NJ Department of Environmental Protection (DEP), the US Environmental Protection Agency (EPA), and the Food and Drug Administration (FDA). The potatble and non potable microbiological water tests are conducted per Standard Methods and are certified by the EPA and DEP. Milk and dairy tests are performed for % fat content, antibiotic residue, and somatic cells.

#### REQUIREMENTS (EDUCATION / EXPERIENCE / LICENSES)

EDUCATION: Graduation from an accredited college or university with a Bachelor's degree in the biological sciences including or supplemented by 12 semester hour credits in specific microbiological courses in the study of microorganisms which includes bacteriology, virology, medical parasitology, and mycology.

EXPERIENCE: Three (3) years of experience in a public health or clinical laboratory conducting diagnostic microbiological tests and examinations; one (1) year of which shall have been in a supervisory capacity.

NOTE: A Master's degree in Microbiology may be substituted for one year of the required non supervisory experience.

LICENSE: Appointee will be required to possess a driver's license valid in New Jersey only if the operation of a vehicle, rather than employee mobility, is necessary to perform the essential duties of the position.
