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#### **GENERAL DESCRIPTION**

Under the direction of a supervisor within the Division of Community Health Services, Community Health and Wellness Unit, Office of Tobacco Free, Nutrition and Fitness, the individual employed in this position receives training in analytic practices and procedures to be used in the collection, compilation, tabulation and application of data and other related information.

Appointees who complete the twelve (12) month training period successfully will be eligible for advancement to the journeyman level title.

#### REQUIREMENTS (EDUCATION / EXPERIENCE / LICENSES)

EDUCATION: Graduation from an accredited college or university with a Bachelor's degree.

LICENSE: Appointee will be required to possess a driver's license valid in New Jersey only if the operation of a vehicle, rather than employee mobility is necessary to perform the essential duties of the position.
