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GENERAL DESCRIPTION

Under the limited supervision in Department of Health the Database Analyst 2 will design, develop, and maintain the database for performance. This position may function as a lead worker, providing the analysis and programing to evaluate different modules in applications. Senior level experience is needed to develop stored procedures and functions using Oracle. This position will generate monthly statistics for Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC), generate data to be used in data lakes for dashboard. Will use Oracle Apex/Tableau to generate these reports. This position will be tasked with developing new methods based on requirements to support the enhancement for the application and will coordinate with stakeholders for assisting in gathering, managing and maintaining the application. The Database Analyst 2 will further provide technical to NJIIS bi-directional web-based immunization information exchange, analyze application issues and troubleshoots problems, and assist in the development of the different module within NJIIS. Will promote and support efforts to implement interfaces with NJIIS using HL7 bi-directional messaging. Provides system support to users. Ensure data collection via interface is in accordance with HL7 specifications. Under the limited supervision in Department of Health the Database Analyst 2 will design, develop, and maintain the database for performance. This position may function as a lead worker, providing the analysis and programing to evaluate different modules in applications. Senior level experience is needed to develop stored procedures and functions using Oracle.

This position may be eligible to participate in the Department's pilot telework program, which offers eligible employees the opportunity to work remotely for up to two (2) days per week, as approved by management.

This position will generate monthly statistics for Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC), generate data to be used in data lakes for dashboard. Will use Oracle Apex/Tableau to generate these reports. This position will be tasked with developing new methods based on requirements to support the enhancement for the application and will coordinate with stakeholders for assisting in gathering, managing and maintaining the application.

REQUIREMENTS (EDUCATION / EXPERIENCE / LICENSES)

EDUCATION: Graduation from an accredited college or university with an Associate's degree in Computer Science. EXPERIENCE: Three (3) years of systems analysis, applications programming, design, systems programming and/or database administration experience in the data processing field of which one (1) year shall have been in database design, analysis, and or implementation.

NOTE: A general Bachelor's degree can be substituted for one (1) year of experience in systems analysis, application programming, design, systems programming, and/or database administration.

NOTE: A specific Bachelor's degree in Computer Science can be substituted for two (2) years of experience in systems analysis, application programming, design, systems programming, and/or database administration.

Special Note Substituting Experience for Education: Experience in the study of work methods and processes, the analysis of varied types of data, the design and preparation of systems and programs, the operation of multiprogramming computer systems and work in the data processing support areas of input/output control or reliability support may be substituted for the required education on a year-for-year basis with thirty (30) semester hour credits being equal to one (1) year of experience.

NOTE: A Master's degree in Computer Science may be substituted for three (3) years of experience in systems analysis, application programming, design, systems programming, and/or database administration.

Special Note Substituting Experience for Education: Experience in the study of work methods and processes, the analysis of varied types of data, the design and preparation of systems and programs, the operation of multiprogramming computer systems and work in the data processing support areas of input/output control or reliability support may be substituted for the required education on a year-for-year basis with thirty (30) semester hour credits being equal to one (1) year of experience.

NOTE: Formal training in data processing received at an accredited institution may be submitted with your application for an evaluation by the Department of Personnel for possible credit. These training courses will be examined to see how they compare, both in hours and content, to college courses to which they equate. In-house training courses will not be accepted as meeting this criterion; thus, they will not be evaluated.

LICENSE: Appointees will be required to possess a driver's license valid in New Jersey only if the operation of a vehicle, rather than employee mobility, is necessary to perform the essential duties of the position.
