<p>Under supervision of a supervisor at Greystone Park Psychiatric Hospital takes a leading part in the operation and maintenance of power and heating plants and auxiliary equipment; does related work as required.</p> <p>This position is covered by the Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services (CMS) Rule and Executive Order 283, requiring all employees to be fully vaccinated. To comply with that requirement, employees must provide proof of vaccination status. REQUIREMENTS (EDUCATION / EXPERIENCE / LICENSES)			
<p>EXPERIENCE: Two (2) years of experience in work involving the operation and repair of stationary steam boilers and auxiliary equipment of a power plant or high pressure heating plant.</p> <p>LICENSE: Appointees must possess an appropriate Operating Engineer's license (Blue Seal minimum) of the appropriate grade, issued by the New Jersey Department of Labor.</p> <p>NOTE: Candidates will be admitted to the examination who possess any grade Operating Engineer's license, but appointments to specific vacancies will be contingent upon possession of the appropriate license for the size and type equipment involved.</p> <p>Appointee will be required to possess a driver's license valid in New Jersey only if the operation of a vehicle rather than employee mobility, is necessary to perform the essential duties of the position.</p>
