#### **GENERAL DESCRIPTION**

The Northern Regional Medical Examiner Office is seeking candidates to administratively assist the pathologists, Investigators, and morgue staff. Duties and responsibilities would include, but not be limited to, transcribing autopsy reports, external exams, and other requested reports for postmortem cases to include preparation of case files. In addition, this successful candidate will also perform data entry into the Case Management System (CMS) database of current status for all cases and perform death certificate amendments. Applicants should possess a strong communication and customer service skill set as this position will interact with families, law enforcement and non-law enforcement.

## REQUIREMENTS (EDUCATION / EXPERIENCE / LICENSES)

EXPERIENCE: Successful completion of the six (6) month training period as an Agency Services Representative Trainee
