GENERAL DESCRIPTION				
Under direction of a supervisory official, plans, coordinates, or may assist staff of a higher level with various aspects of a public health program; does other related duties as required. Conduct covert Compliance Buys on current or new vendors for the purpose of investigation of a complaint and to assess compliance with Federal and State regulations. Conduct follow-up Compliance Buys after re-training of vendors. Prepare Compliance Buy packets for filing. Discuss status of Compliance Buys with Program Manager or Vendor Unit Supervisor to determine next course of action. Prepare appropriate paperwork and submit to Vendor Unit Supervisor or Program Manager for review. Assist in monitoring of current or new retail vendors. Prepare monitoring forms and submit to supervisor for review within two weeks of visit. Upon approval, prepare letter and advise vendors of compliance or non-compliance. Assist with conducting vendor training related to non-compliance issues. Monitor local agency and Farmers Market Nutrition Program/Senior Farmers Market Nutrition Program as requested by Program Manager. Assist with the Vendor and Farmers' Market re-authorization process that occurs every three years. Conduct other duties relative to Food Delivery Services and/or Vendor tasks as needed.

EDUCATION: Graduation from an accredited college or university with a Bachelor's degree. EXPERIENCE: Two (2) year of experience in a health or social service related program which shall have included responsibilities for interviewing, investigating, and/or conducting public health care surveys or patient care services. NOTE: Applicants who do not possess the required education may substitute experience as indicated on a year- for-year basis. LICENSE: Appointee will be required to possess a driver's license valid in New Jersey only if the operation of a vehicle, rather than employee mobility, is necessary to perform the essential duties of the position.
