GENERAL DESCRIPTION

The position holder is to supervise and coordinate a team of investigators that ensure all allegations and suspicions of abuse, neglect and exploitation are properly investigated, and that the health, safety and well-being of individuals receiving services at New Jersey psychiatric hospitals are maintained. The position holder will be the supervisor of a unit of Quality Assurance Specialists. The position holder will be the liaison between the Department of Health, Division of Health Facility Survey & Field Operations, Office of Investigations and Ann Klein Forensic Center Risk Management, Employee Relations Office and hospital management.

REQUIREMENTS (EDUCATION / EXPERIENCE / LICENSES)

License: A license as a Registered Nurse in the State of New Jersey.

Experience: Five (5) years of experience in the monitoring and/or evaluation of clinical or human services records and/or programs in a hospital or other health services facility or in a human services agency.

Note: A Bacherlor's degree, and four (4) years of experience in the monitoring and/or evaluation of clinical or human services records and/or programs in a hospital or other health services facility or in a human services agency may be substituted for the above license and experience requirements.

Note: A Master's degree in Public Health or a health care related field may be substituted for one (1) year of indicated experience.

License: Appointee will be required to possess a driver's license valid in New Jersey only if the operation of a vehicle, rather than employee mobility, is necessary to perform the essential duties of the position.
