#### **GENERAL DESCRIPTION**

Under the supervision of the ECLS Organic Testing Program Manager, supervises the receiving, checking, logging in, and assumes legal custody of samples submitted to the Environmental and Chemical Laboratory Services (ECLS) for analysis. Ensures that established procedures required to maintain chain-of-custody for samples having legal significance are followed. Supervises the routing and distribution of samples or sample aliquots to appropriate laboratory groups or individual analysts to ensure that all requested tests, examinations, and analyses are performed. Supervises preparation and distribution of sample containers and other supplies used by sampling personnel from Department of Health programs and other state agencies, and orders materials as needed to maintain adequate supplies.

Under supervision of professional laboratory personnel, supervises and conducts tests and analyses in analytical chemistry laboratory; or may supervise other technical or support personnel in the preparation of laboratory samples or related data; does other related duties as required. Perform and Supervise Biomonitoring program sample collection schedule, receiving and storage operation.

Perform and supervise the maintenance of laboratory records including placing supply purchase order, acquiring vendor quotes, maintaining routine logbooks for freezer/refrigerator, maintaining standard/reagents/consumable inventories, thermometer calibrations, pipette calibrations, and the management of chemical wastes. Consideration will be given to the candidate with clinical experience in addition to environmental testing experience and experience with a LIMS system, with the Element system experience being the most favorable. Knowledge of State and Federal regulations pertaining to certified environmental testing laboratories.

# REQUIREMENTS (EDUCATION / EXPERIENCE / LICENSES)

EDUCATION: Successful completion of 60 semester hour credits at an accredited college or university, 24 hours of which shall have been in the biological, chemical, and/or physical sciences.

NOTE: Successful completion of a certificate program in Clinical Laboratory Technology may be substituted for the above education.

#### **EXPERIENCE:**

Two (2) years of experience as a technician in a public health, hospital, clinic or research laboratory performing various types of tests.

NOTE: Applicants who do not posses the required college or certificate in Clinical Laboratory Technology may substitute two (2) additional years of experience
