GENERAL DESCRIPTION

The Research Scientist 2 will be responsible for performing surveillance and research projects in support of Community Health Worker (CHW) program and Community Health Worker Institute. Will reviews and analyzes all CHW publications and other documents pertaining to current research developments and disseminates information to research staff. Prepares sound, accurate reports relating to research, grant, and other activities containing findings, conclusions, and recommendations.

The ideal candidate for this position should have grant writing experience. The candidate must be comfortable with public speaking as they will serve as a point of contact and may be tasked with presenting to internal and external partners and should be able to provide training and assistance for CHWs, COVID-19, and special project grantees. This position will also be responsible for assessing initiative needs, making project recommendations, and ensuring that grant deliverable deadlines are met. The candidate should be able to work under limited supervision.

This position may be eligible to participate in the Department's pilot telework program, which offers eligible employees the opportunity to work remotely for up to two (2) days per week, as approved by management.

REQUIREMENTS (EDUCATION / EXPERIENCE / LICENSES)

EDUCATION: Graduation from an accredited college or university with a Master's degree in a discipline appropriate to the position.

EXPERIENCE: Three (3) years of full-time experience in a field appropriate to the position.

NOTE: A Doctorate in a discipline appropriate to the position may be substituted for two (2) years of experience indicated above.

LICENSE: Appointees will be required to possess a valid driver's license valid in New Jersey only if the operation of a vehicle, rather than employee mobility, is necessary to perform the essentials duties of the position.
