GENERAL DESCRIPTION

Under direction of a supervisory official in the NJ Public Health and Environmental Laboratories, the Laboratory Technician position will handle, process and accession laboratory specimens and conduct routine laboratory analyses in virological or microbiological laboratory.

Performs other related work including sample preparation, reagent/buffer preparation, instrument maintenance and troubleshooting, data assessment, and results reporting using our laboratory's Laboratory Information Management System (LIMS) as required.

Learns to be responsible for the acquisition, storage, preservation, recording, and proper use of laboratory equipment, materials, and supplies.

Timely, consistent, and high-quality work habits, including attention to detail, are essential.

General knowledge of principles and practices of laboratory analyses, assessing method performance, evaluation of data quality, and interpretation of results and findings.

General knowledge of laboratory instrumentation and automation systems, as well as procedures pertaining to laboratory analyses.

Previous experience conducting laboratory analyses using Enzyme Linked Immunosorbent Assay (ELISA) in a clinical environment is preferred but not required.

REQUIREMENTS (EDUCATION / EXPERIENCE / LICENSES)

EDUCATION:Successful completion of 60 semester hour credits from an accredited college or university which shall have included 24 semester hour credits in the biological and/or physical sciences.

NOTE: Successful completion of a certificate program in Clinical Laboratory Technology may be substituted for the above education.

NOTE: Applicants who do not possess the required credits or certificate in Clinical Laboratory Technology may substitute two (2) years of experience as a technician in a public health, hospital, clinical, or research laboratory performing bacteriological, chemical, histological, serology, and/or virological tests.

LICENSE: Appointee will be required to possess a driver's license valid in New Jersey only if the operation of a vehicle, rather than employee mobility, is necessary to perform essential duties of the position.
