Analyzes and prepares data for publication, monitors and reports on data trends over time, provides technical assistance to CHW staff and partners related to epidemiology/surveillance. Participate in the preparation of grant applications (federal and otherwise) to provide technical expertise in the areas of surveillance and epidemiology. Participate in the preparation and submission of reports (grants and otherwise) to provide technical expertise in the arease of surveillance and evaluation. Serve as a liasion to other data collecting arms of NJDOH to share and analyze data required for CHW programs. Must be knowledgeable and experienced in research methods, statistical analysis and possess strong writing skills.</p>
