Conduct pasteurization unit tests at Grade A milk plants in accordance with the FDA standards of proficiency.

Conducts wholesale food and juice inspections under the FDA contract agreement.

Conducts bottled water plant inspections and assists in license application review.

Responds to emergencies related to general sanitation and food protection.

Conducts enforcement actions as needed.

Attends comprehensive training programs in the areas of environmental health.

Prepares technical reports which contains findings, conclusions, and recommendations.

Represents the Department at appropriate meetings, conferences, workshops, etc.

### REQUIREMENTS (EDUCATION / EXPERIENCE / LICENSES)

#### **EDUCATION:**

Graduation from an accredited college or university with a Bachelor's degree including or supplemented by thirty-two (32) semester hour credits (undergraduate or graduate) in the biological sciences, physical sciences, environmental sciences, mathematics, or any combination thereof.

#### LICENSE

Applicants must possess a license as a Registered Environmental Health Specialist issued by the NJ Department of Health.

NOTE: Appointees will be required to possess a driver's license valid in New Jersey only if the operation of a vehicle, rather than employee mobility, is necessary to perform essential duties of the position.
