<p>Under direction of the Communicable Disease Service, provides consultation on nursing related program activities essential to implementing program objectives to respond to transmission of COVID-19. Provides consultation to other nursing and public health professionals concerning nursing-related program activities, such as assisting in the response to COVID-19 transmission in healthcare settings, long-term care facilities, schools, daycare, camps, and other congregate settings. May assist in response to COVID-19 outbreaks. Establishes and maintains cooperative working relationships with intra and interdepartmental and other government agencies and the provider community. Prepares and/or revises procedures, standards, assessment forms, and criteria for professional staff. May conduct onsite visits in response to COVID-19 prevention and response activities within healthcare facilities, schools, long-term care, or other congregate settings.</p> <p>Note: For this particular position, we are seeking a nursing consultant with school, educational or public health setting experience to work with a small team of public health professionals within CDS in order to strengthen outreach and collaboration between schools and other public health partners.</p>
