Department of Health and Senior Services Proposes to Readopt N.J.A.C. 8:41A Governing Emergency Medical Technician- Paramedic: Training and Certification

The Office of Emergency Medical Services of the Division of Health Infrastructure Preparedness and Emergency Response of the Public Health Services Branch of the Department of Health and Senior Services (Department) is proposing to readopt without change N.J.A.C. 8:41A, which establishes standards governing Emergency Medical Technician-Paramedic training and certification.

The notice of proposal appears in the May 4, 2009, issue of the New Jersey Register.

The public has until July 3, 2009 to comment on the proposal. Persons wishing to comment on the proposal must submit their comments in writing by regular mail to Ruth Charbonneau, Director, Office of Legal and Regulatory Affairs, Office of the Commissioner, NJ Department of Health and Senior Services, P O Box 360, Trenton, NJ 08625-0360.

Written comments must be postmarked on or before July 3, 2009, which is the close of the 60-day public comment period. The Department will not accept telefacsimiles or electronic mail messages as official comments on the notice of proposal.
