



Cook Rutledge Fellowship

The New Jersey Department of Health and Senior Services, Office of Minority and Multicultural Health (OMMH), will begin accepting applications for the 2012 Cook/Rutledge Fellowship in January, 2012.

The Cook/Rutledge fellowship is a paid 12 week program offered during the summer to students enrolled in a graduate school program of Medicine, Law, or Public Health.

Prospective Fellows will be required to consult with the OMMH executive director to identify a relevant health equity/health disparity project.
