NJ WorkAbility 2017 Income Guidelines**

<b>Earned Income</b> Money from Employment
250% of Federal Poverty Level For an individual: \$ 61,500 per year (\$ 5,125 per month) For an eligible couple: \$ 82,400 per year (\$ 6,867 per month)
<b>Unearned Income</b> Alimony, Child Support or social security benefits on someone else's account
100% of Federal Poverty Level \$ 1,005 per month for singles \$ 1,354 per month for eligible couples
<b>Asset Requirements</b>
Individuals must have less than \$ 20,000 Married couples must have less than \$ 30,000
<b>Assets Not Included</b>
IRA/401 K account funds Value of home Value of vehicle
<b>Disregarded Income</b>
<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Social Security Disability Benefits received by an individual on their own account are disregarded</li><li>• Railroad Retirement System Benefits received by an individual on their own account are disregarded</li></ul>
