In order to bill for SUD Peer Services, Independent Clinics Drug/Alcohol (all outpatient levels of care) must enroll their Peer Specialists with NJFC Medicaid.

Prior to enrollment, each Peer Specialist must obtain an NPI number by applying online at <a href="https://nppes.cms.hhs.gov">https://nppes.cms.hhs.gov</a>. Anticipate approximately 10 days to receive your NPI.

Once you have the NPI, complete the Peer addendum found under "provider enrollment" at <a href="https://www.njmmis.com">www.njmmis.com</a>.

See column on left side, Select "Provider Enrollment Application"

Go down to "provider type" drop down box and select "peer – addendum"

Select either "download PDF" or "mail a blank enrollment application"

Select: "complete request"

The addendum will link the Peer's NPI number to the independent clinic's provider number.

When submitting a claim for Peer services, the biller shall list the care manager NPI as the "rendering" provider and list the independent clinic NPI and provider number as the "billing" provider.
