Name of Program: Provide Supportive Housing Services to an Existing Caseload in Union County

Purpose: The Division of Mental Health and Addiction Services (DMHAS) has made one award to assume operation of an existing Supportive Housing Program serving a minimum of 35 individuals in Union County.

This RFP will pair housing subsidies funded by the Division and administered by the New Jersey Housing Mortgage and Finance Agency (NJHMFA) with service dollars to develop or expand community supportive housing programs. A reduction will be made commensurate with the amount of Medicaid revenue realized, once the awarded provider begins billing under Community Support Services (CSS). When vacancies occur, DMHAS seeks to facilitate the discharge of individuals who are on Conditional Extension Pending Placement (CEPP) status.
