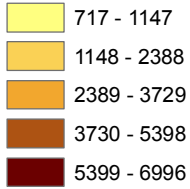

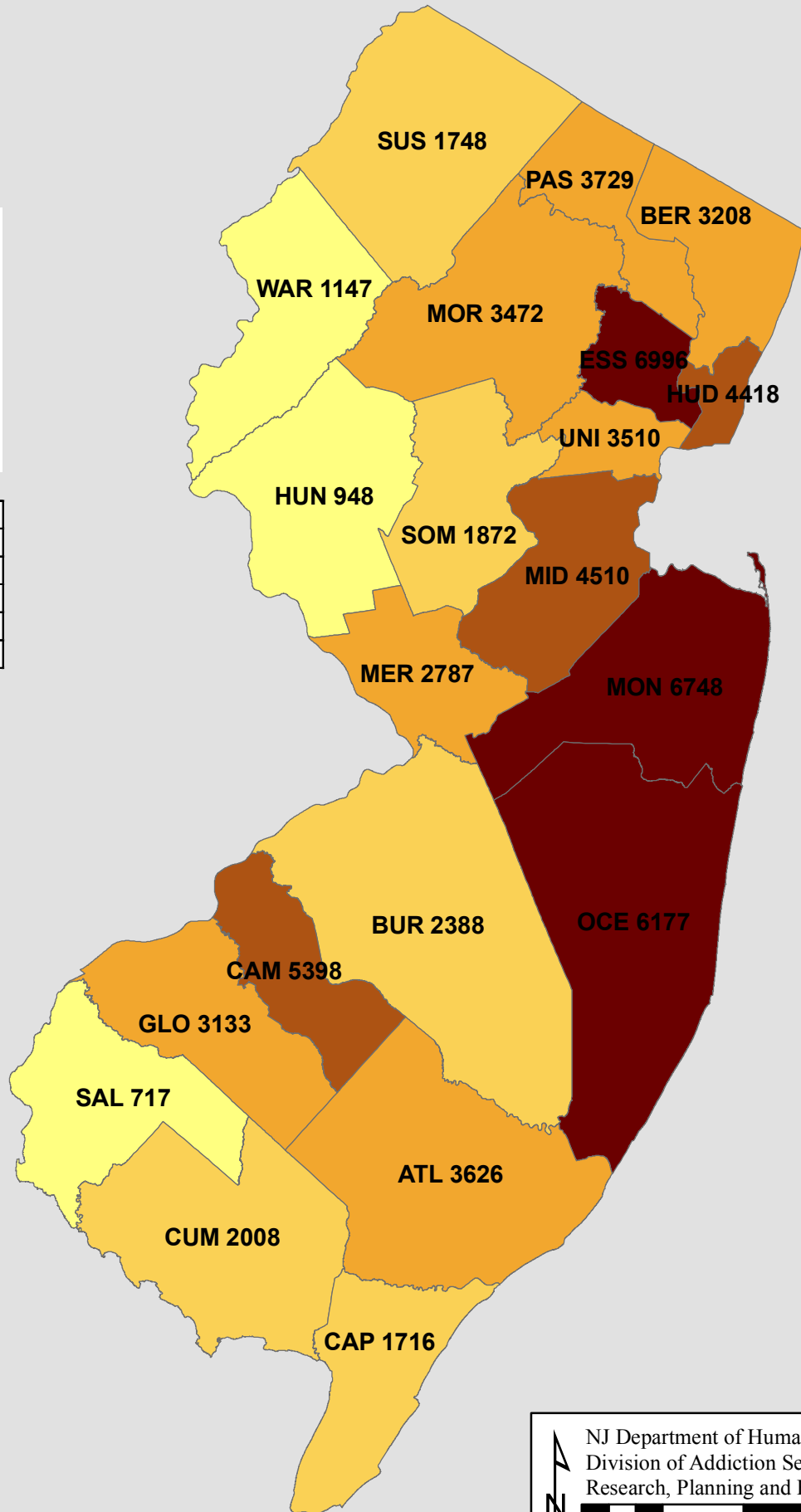

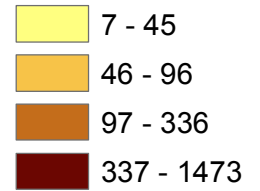

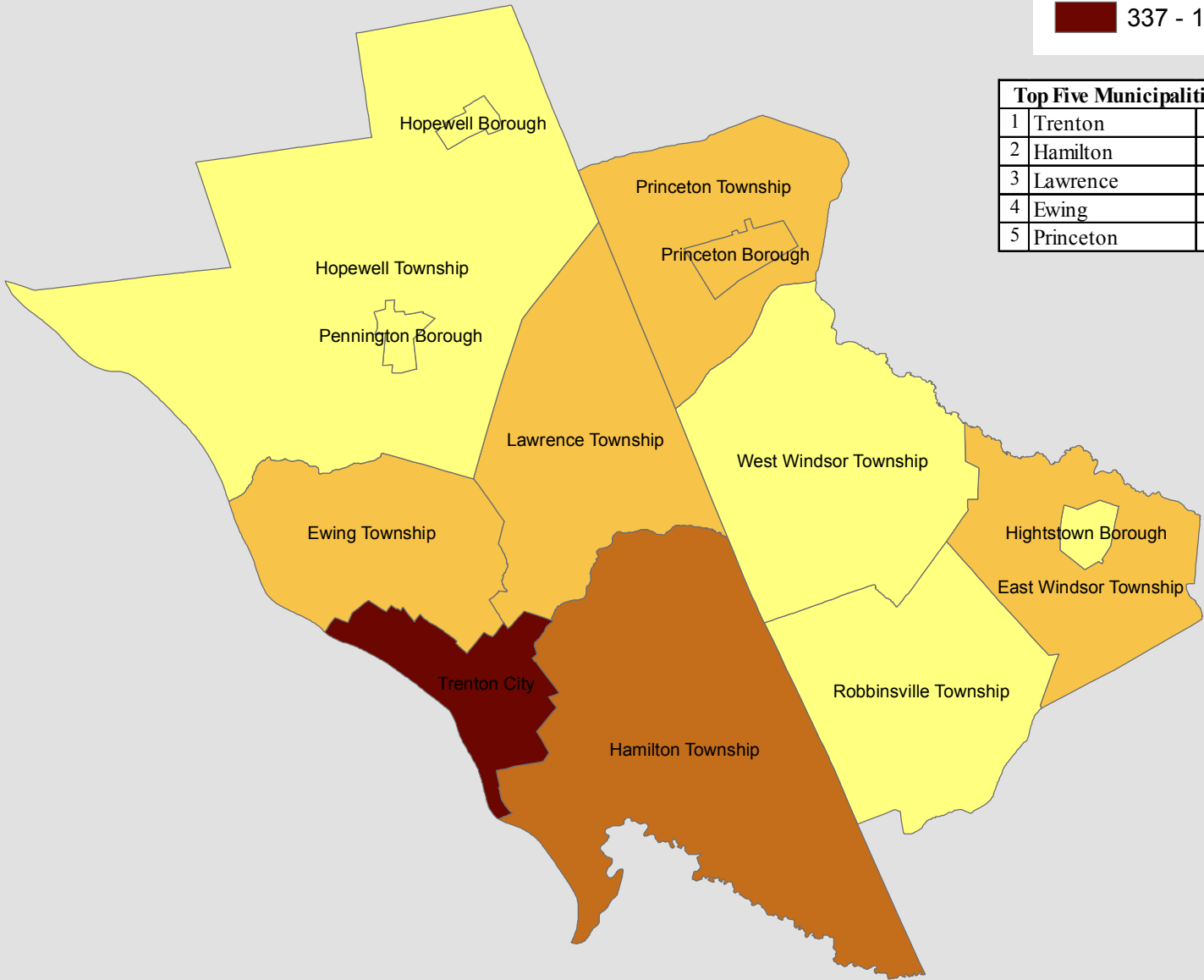
2010 Mercer County Substance Abuse Admissions by Municipality of Residence
